

## TOPMOST PROJECT

Further to my last newsletter you will recall that we are involved in a Leonardo project called **TopMost**. Could all staff that deal with employer engagement and apprenticeship programmes, please raise the employers awareness on the Topmost project that we are running with our European Partners.

The Director of the project Antonio Mir from Xabec – Spain made the following comments regarding the project

“The ToP-MoSt project is aligned with the European Strategy 2020, which aims to promote the mobility of students across Europe with effective recognition of the skills acquired in the College abroad. In this sense, the ToP-MoSt project becomes reality for the Colleges from six different European countries – Spain, Turkey, Germany, Netherland, Italy and UK”.

“The project has two phases: in the first phase each College will identify in the maintenance sector their Learning Outcomes relating to their curriculum. In the second phase, each College will select those Learning Outcomes from the other European partners which are relevant to them to enable student and teacher mobility”.

“This project will benefit students and teachers in terms of the countries they participate in for their mobility as well as the international experience gained by the students and staff on how their curriculum is delivered at the host College”.

As you can see this project is quite important for Dudley College, as it would mean that when the students participate in student mobility they will gain recognition for the work that they undertake with the host organisation”.
