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HIGH QUALITY MOBILITY

✓ Enhancing competences, knowledge and skills



Objective

- ✓ To develop a strategy that allows high quality in mobility of Vocational Training students in the knowledge area of installations and industrial maintenance.

Methodology

- ✓ In a first stage each training centre elaborates a Mobility Handbook which reflects its training offer. Working by technical departments, modules are broken down in Learning Outcomes, indicating at what time of the year the contents are taught. In this way, we can get the necessary transparency in order that each centre to know precisely the training offer of the other centres.

In a second stage the basic mobility tools are developed:

- ✓ **1) Mobility Matrix:** based on the Learning Outcomes described in the Mobility Handbook, it is created a matrix of coincidences that enables the design of future mobility.
- ✓ **2) Mobility Documents:** they structure, specify and optimize the quality of mobility: Memorandum of Understanding and Learning Agreement.

The Mobility Matrix is the key to success, because it makes easy and simple to reach an agreement in the mobility documents.

Benefits for Schools



It allows the design of mobility choosing significant and measurable Learning Outcomes, regardless of the modules and the curricula of the host institution.

Impact



It is expected a significant increase in the total number of mobility between the participating centres. Moreover the methodology allows the incorporation of new centres, so in the medium term future we may establish a network for the achievement of the targets set in the Europe 2020 Strategy.
