The Annex of the Memorandum of Understanding is produced by the database, and it will be automatically updated when any common learning outcome be updated.

The tool is prepared to receive new partners and new common learning outcomes. The new information has to be sent to the technical responsible of the mobility tool and send the information to be studied and included in the tool.

#### 1. Objectives of the Memorandum of Understanding

The Memorandum of Understanding forms the framework for cooperation between the competent
